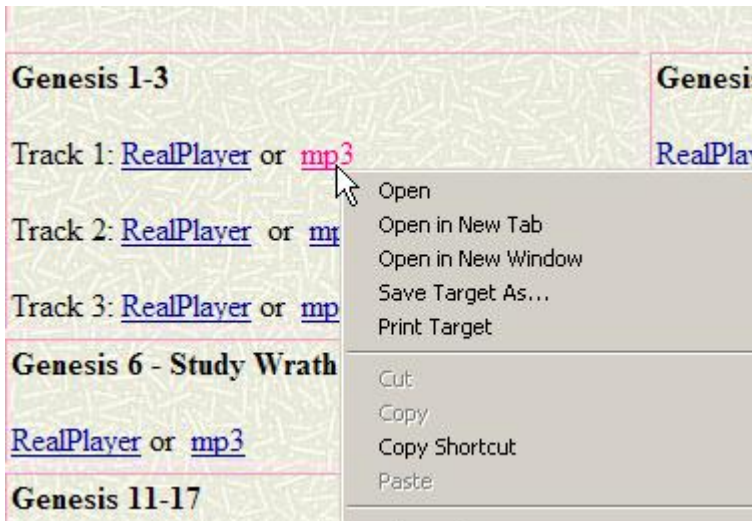
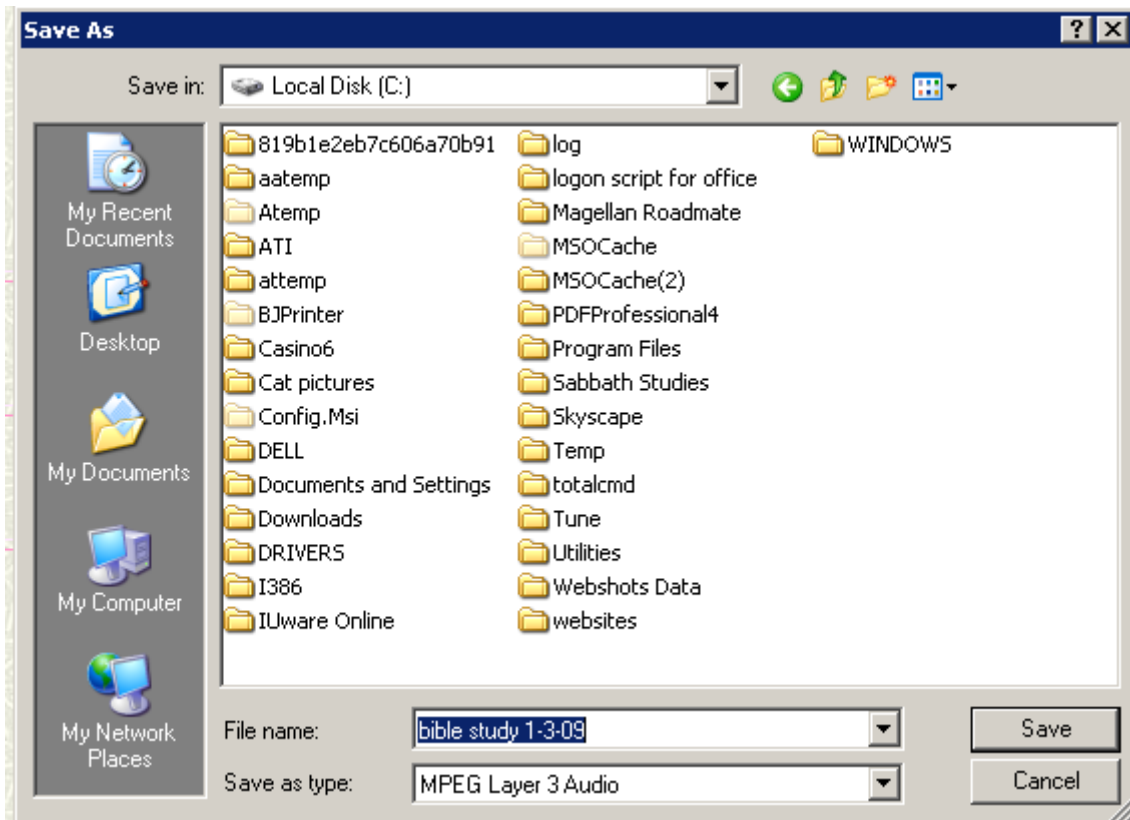


How to download mp3 files and then burn them to a CD

1. **First right click on the file you want..**

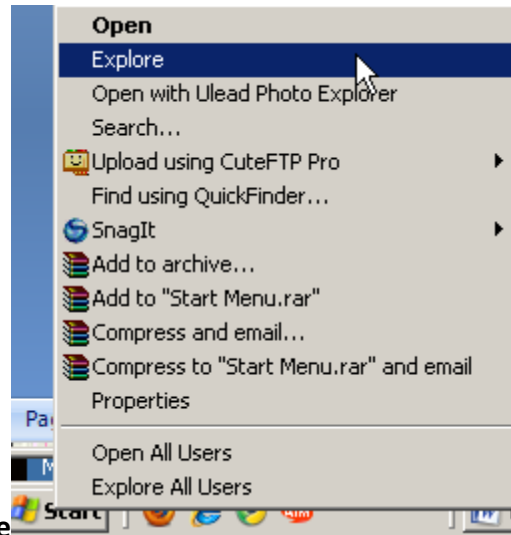


2. **Then left click on Save Target As And choose where to save it as.**



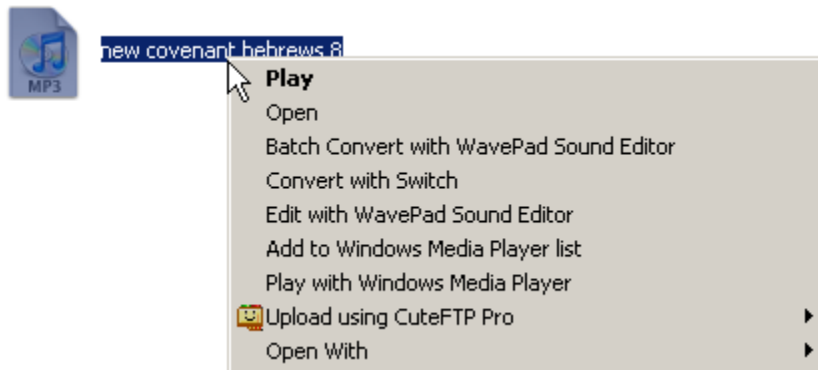
3. **Then remember where you saved it!!! You will need to find it later.**

4. After downloading it to your computer go to where that file is using windows explorer. Right click on the start button on the task bar.. then left click on the

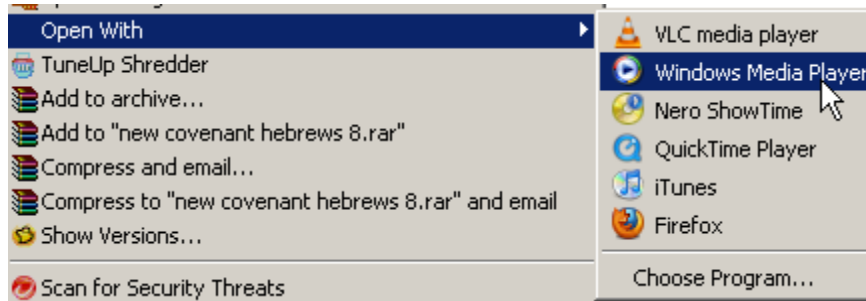

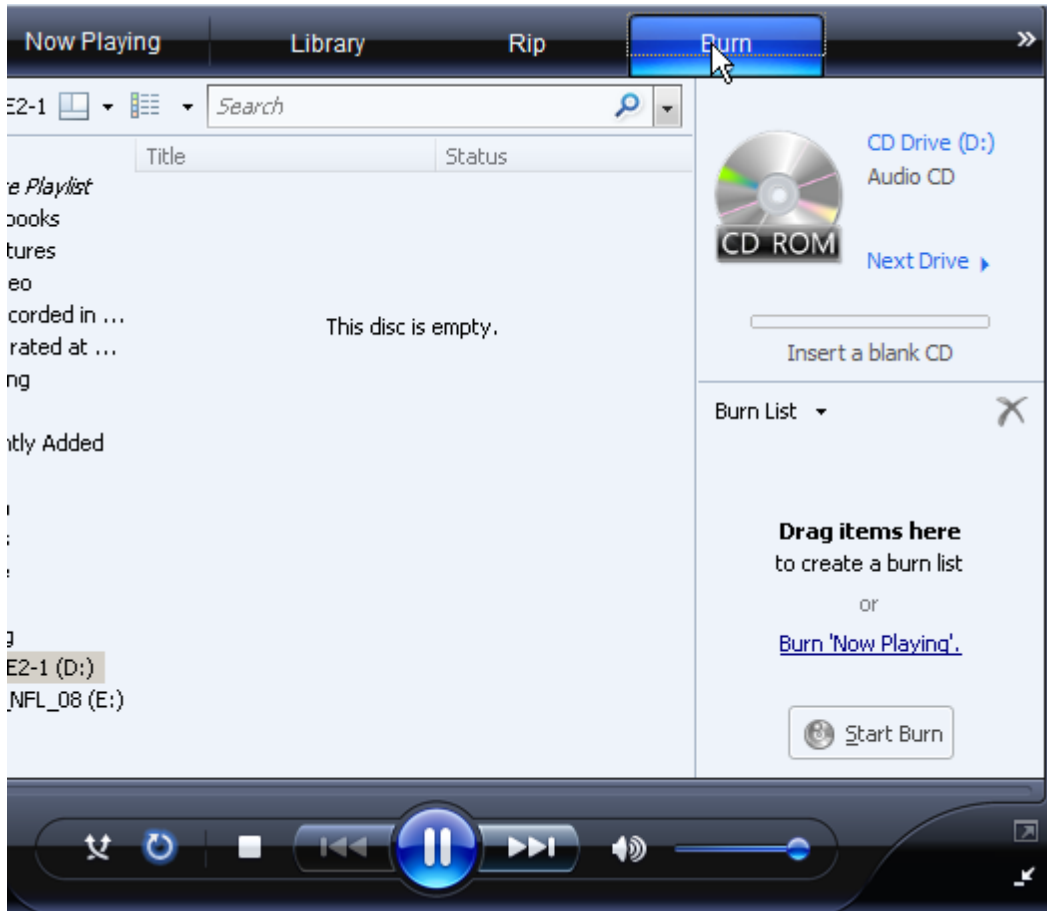
5. Then go to the file you downloaded, okay this is why you needed to remember where you downloaded it to. Once there, right click on the file (an mp3 file)...



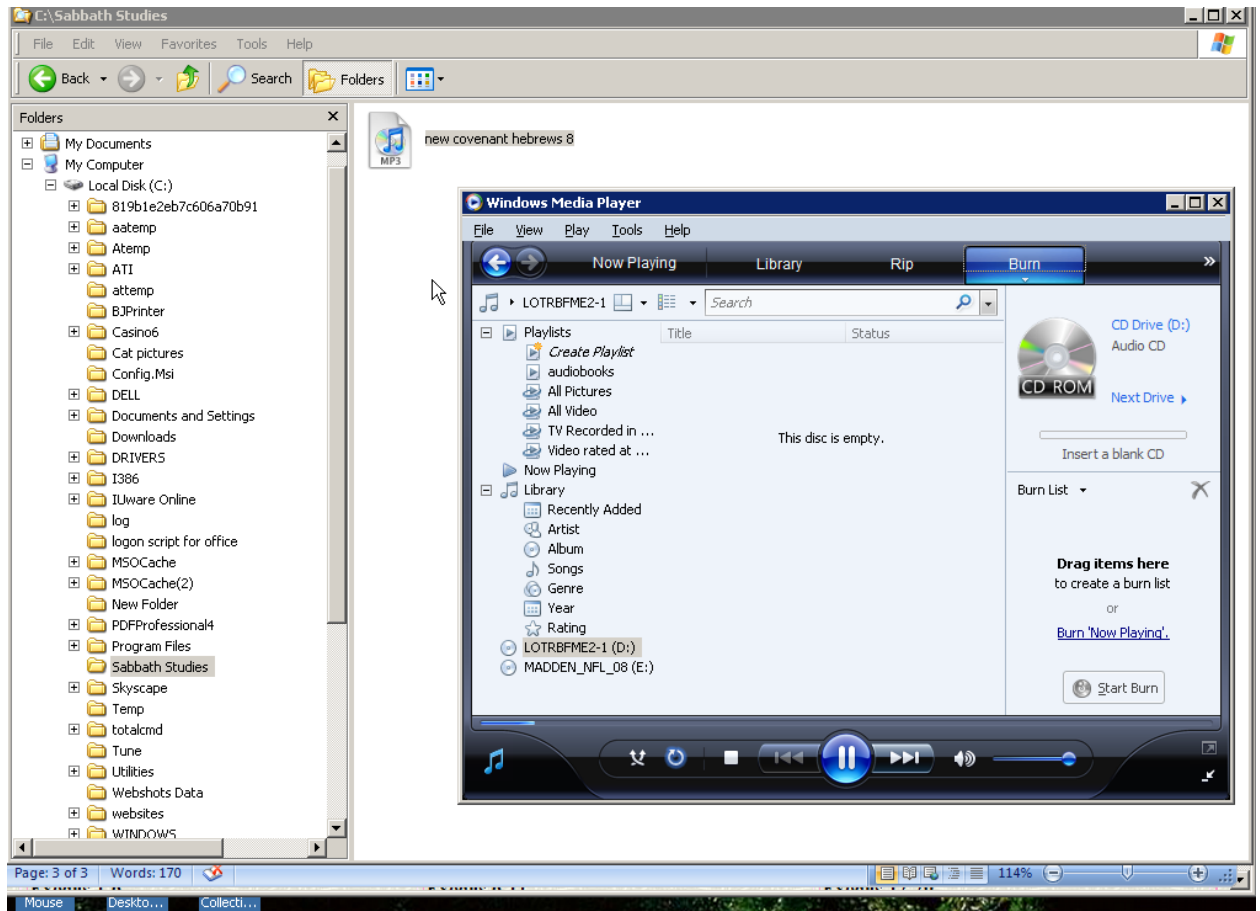
6. Then move down to the open with... and left click on windows media player ...



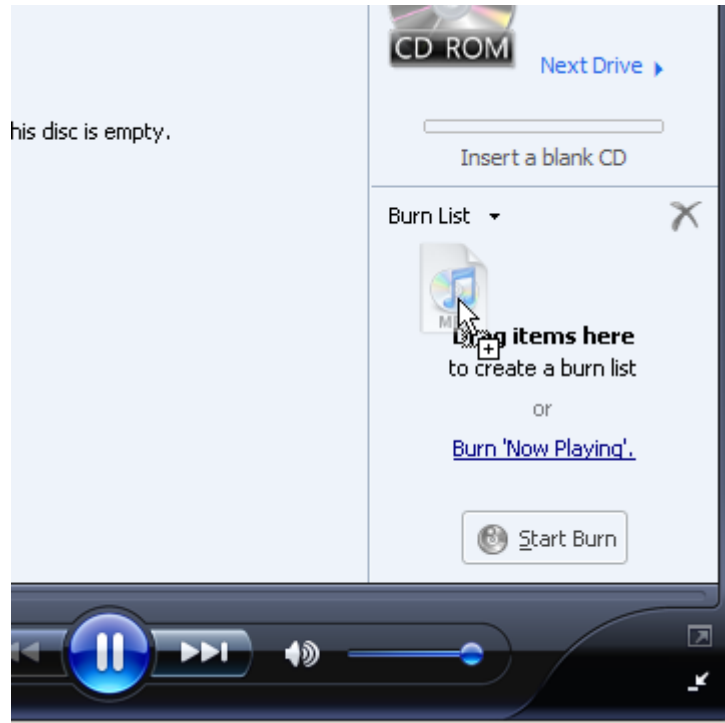
7. Now if you have version 11 windows media player you would click on the tab BURN..



8. **Ok, tricky part you need to have the windows media player small enough that you can still see the file in explorer..**

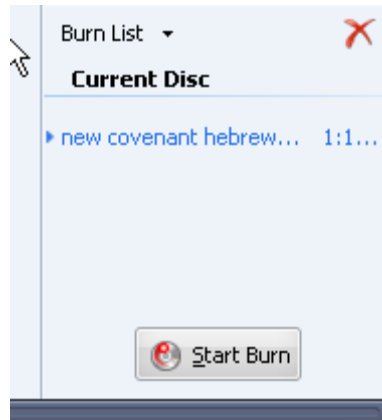


9. Then left click on the file and continue to hold the button down drag it (move it) to the box in the media player that says drag items here to create a burn list, and drop it (let



the left button go)..

10. Now you will see the file in that box and the Start Burn button will darker not grayed



out any longer..

11. Making sure you have a blank CD in your CD drive, press the start burn button. It will take a few minutes to 5 to 10 depending on your computer, but that is all you need to do. Questions? Older Windows Media player, email me and I will see what I can do.
