

FIRST “EXODUS”

Israel (circumcised)
In Covenant
Sons of the Kingdom
Rich (in the things of God)

The Nations (uncircumcised)
Not in Covenant
Gentiles
Poor

**Informed
Called**

**Uninformed
Not called**

“Many are called, but few are chosen.”

Abraham was called of God.

His descendants thru Isaac, continued in covenant, so we can include them with the “called.”

All of Israel was: circumcised, in covenant, rich in the knowledge of God and His blessings. Christ called them, “the Sons of the Kingdom” () And He said that many of them would be “cast out” “when the Son of Man comes in His glory.” ()

Some will remain faithful to covenant - others will forsake the covenant - and will be cast out.

Before the death of Christ - Israelites and Gentiles lived parallel but separate lives. Israelites did not believe that non-Israelites could be “saved” except by converting to Judaism, becoming circumcised and agreeing to keep all of the Laws of Moses.

After the death of Christ - the “call” went out to “the nations.”

Physical circumcision was no longer necessary as a sign of the covenant.

Jesus said, “If you would enter into life, keep the commandments.”

Belief in Christ - risen from the dead, submission to Him as Lord and Savior -

But not everyone has heard that call.

THE JUDGMENT @ THE RETURN OF CHRIST IN GLORY

Will judge the “sons of the kingdom.”

Will judge the “called.”

Will judge the informed.

Will judge those who entered into covenant.

Will NOT judge the uninformed, the uncalled, the ignorant.

These people will rise in the second resurrection, after the 1000 years.

Then they WILL be “called,” taught, and invited to enter into covenant.

GREATER EXODUS

Again two groups.

Israel (now priests of God)
Sons of God (Immortal)
Circumcised (in heart and in flesh)

The Nations
Mortal
Uncircumcised

The Gog-Magog battle is a rebellion. During the 8th Day (1000 years) those raised second will be taught of God and of His law. They will no longer be ignorant or uninformed. Many will enter into covenant with Christ as Lord and King. Others - multitudes - like the sand of the sea (Revelation 20:8) will resent the rulership of Christ. They will be deceived (by Satan) into thinking they can overthrow the rulership of Christ, and they will come up to attack Jerusalem, where Christ sits as King. God will defend His city. Fire will come down from heaven and consume them.

This fire is, I believe, the glory of God. This “fire” will kill the attackers, but then their bodies will be gathered and buried. The clean-up will take seven years.

TYPE: (First Exodus) The rebellion of the 250 princes, against Moses, lead by Korah, Dathan and Abirim.

JUDGMENT BY FIRE (A Repeating prophecy)

1. At the second coming. ---- The earth will be burned up.
2. At the Gog-Magog battle ----- They will be consumed by “fire” from heaven.
3. At the final judgment of the dead ----- The lost will be destroyed in the Lake of Fire.

In the first two - living people are destroyed.

In the final judgment those judged are dead, and are therefore not conscious.

Only God’s memory of them is finally destroyed.
